north atlantic treaty organization (nato) security briefing - special security controls. basic classification markings required by the nispom apply equally to nato classified documents. for example, a nato secret, confidential, or restricted document must be marked "nato" at the top and bottom, in addition to the classification markings. a top secret nato document must be marked cosmic at the top
