2018 poverty income guidelines - nebraska - the new poverty guidelines have been used to develop the care management program sliding fee scale. using the method described in the program regulations and making minor adjustments to assure coverage of all income levels, a revised sliding fee scale has been developed. this sliding fee scale uses monthly income.
