

## Nice Guidelines Wound Care

**pressure ulcers prevention and management - nice** - applies to all people in nhs care and in care funded by the nhs. recommendations for prevention include methods for identification and risk assessment and the preventive measures that should be applied. treatment of pressure ulcers includes recommendations on wound care, adjunctive therapies and support surfaces.

**wound assessment and management guideline** - b. this guideline replaces the previous wound care guidance published in 2007. national and international guidelines have been considered and reviewed (epuap & npuap 2014, nice 2014, ewma 2005, ewma 2004, ewma 2008, dh 2010a, dh 2010b, dh2010c, rcn 2006, wuwhs 2008a, dh 2010d, nice 2004, nice 2008). c.
